### Attendance

Regular attendance at school is significant to a child's educational development and progress. When a child's attendance falls to 90% or below it is classed as persistent absence by Sefton Council. We hope that by working together, their attendance will improve and they will achieve their full potential in school. The Government are also monitoring poor attendance and have worked with the NHS to produce this document: Is my child too ill for school? We reward good attendance each week and are aiming for at least 96%. Our Reception class had the highest attendance for last week with 100%. Other classes attendance was follows: Y2 - 97.8%, Y4 - 96.3%, Y3 - 95.5%, Y5 - 95%, N - 94.9%, Y1 - 92.8%, Y6 - 86.4%.

The classes in green are above our target of 96% and those in red are below, some significantly below. We will be targeting those with poor attendance.
